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Read the following paragraph to answer the following two questions (Q. 49 to Q. 50)

Tailgating another vehicle is unsafe and illegal. Many rear – end collisions are caused by drivers following too close to the vehicle in front of them. The rules state that the driver must keep sufficient distance from the vehicle in front in order to stop safely and avoid a collision. Driver should allow a minimum two seconds gap between their vehicle and the one ahead. At 60 kms/hour, this equates to 33 meters ; at a 100 it equates to 55 meters. More distance is needed to safely stop in rain or poor visibility.
